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Application Form and Instructions

Each year, the Mason Orchestral Society awards music scholarships in memory of former Music Director and Conductor Brian Arnold. Young musicians who are members of the Society for 2010-2011 are invited to apply for the 2011 Brian Arnold Scholarship. Winners may use their scholarship money to defray the cost of summer music camps or tours, private lessons, needed musical equipment or for another music-related purpose approved by the MOS.

Scholarship recipients are selected after an application and audition process on the basis of their musical potential, development and improvement, desire, preparation and performance. Winners will be announced at the spring 2011 concert.

Instructions

Eligibility

In order to be eligible to apply for a Brian Arnold Scholarship, you must be 18 or younger, a member of the Mason Orchestral Society, and participate in the Youth Symphony, String Lesson Program, or Community Orchestra. **Prior years first place winners are not eligible to compete unless auditioning on a different instrument.**

Application Form and Personal Statement

The scholarship application form is attached. The application requests general information and a short personal statement about one or more topics relating to your interest in music.

Audition and Interview

The audition and interview process will last no longer than 15 to 20 minutes and will include:

- A short solo piece of your choosing (lasting no longer than 5 minutes) that you believe represents your current ability level. The solo may be an excerpt from a longer work;
- A short excerpt from the current concert repertoire, which will be selected at the audition;
- A short interview about your essay.
- Only the student and Committee members will be allowed into the audition

Schedule

- The written application and essay **must** be turned in no later than **Wednesday, April 13, 2011**, at the Youth Symphony rehearsal.
